

Post Operation Report

Vitals:

- Heartbeat - 69 bpm
- BP (blood pressure) - 110/62
- Temperature - 99.1

Procedure:

- Patient was put under anesthetic.
- Patient's wound was irrigated with water and the skin was scrubbed with antibacterial soap.
- An incision was cut in the top of the foot aligned with the surgeon's initials (P).
- Internal dissolvable stitches used to suture the muscle in the top of the foot.
- Two 4-inch, stainless steel pins inserted to re-align second and third metatarsals.
- Outer skin on top of foot realigned and stitched up.
- Plaster cast put on after surgery.

Post Operative Diagnosis: 2nd and 3rd metatarsal bone fractured.
Surgery needed to stabilize bones.

- Patient is to stay overnight in the hospital to watch for swelling and control pain.
- Patient has no feeling on the top of the foot, prior to and after surgery.
- In the morning, a physical therapist will aid the patient in walking with crutches and uninjured foot.
- Patient to return for evaluation in 1 week.
- Physical therapy will be recommended after the cast is removed.
